### Hebrews 10:7

#### **Psalm 40:6-8 NIV**

<sup>6</sup> Sacrifice and offering you did not desire—  
but my ears you have opened—  
burnt offerings and sin offerings you did not  
require.

<sup>7</sup> Then I said, "Here I am, I have come—  
it is written about me in the scroll.

<sup>8</sup> I desire to do your will, my God;  
your law is within my heart."

### Hebrews 10:16-17

#### **Jeremiah 31:33-34 NIV**

<sup>33</sup> "This is the covenant I will make with the people of  
Israel  
after that time," declares the Lord.

"I will put my law in their minds  
and write it on their hearts.

I will be their God,  
and they will be my people.

<sup>34</sup> No longer will they teach their neighbor,  
or say to one another, 'Know the Lord,'  
because they will all know me,  
from the least of them to the greatest,"  
declares the Lord.

"For I will forgive their wickedness  
and will remember their sins no more."

### Hebrews 10:30

#### **Deuteronomy 32:35-36 NIV**

<sup>35</sup> It is mine to avenge; I will repay.  
In due time their foot will slip;  
their day of disaster is near  
and their doom rushes upon them."

<sup>36</sup> The Lord will vindicate his people  
and relent concerning his servants  
when he sees their strength is gone  
and no one is left, slave or free.

#### **Psalm 135:14 NIV**

<sup>14</sup> For the Lord will vindicate his people  
and have compassion on his servants.

### Hebrews 10:37

#### **Isaiah 26:20 NIV**

<sup>20</sup> Go, my people, enter your rooms  
and shut the doors behind you;  
hide yourselves for a little while  
until his wrath has passed by.

#### **Habakkuk 2:3 NIV**

<sup>3</sup> For the revelation awaits an appointed time;  
it speaks of the end and will not prove false.  
Though it linger, wait for it;  
it will certainly come  
and will not delay.

#### Joshua 10:24 NIV

<sup>24</sup> When they had brought these kings to Joshua, he summoned all the men of Israel and said to the army commanders who had come with him, "Come here and put your feet on the necks of these kings." So they came forward and placed their feet on their necks.

### Hebrews 10:19

#### Leviticus 16:2 NIV

<sup>2</sup> The Lord said to Moses: "Tell your brother Aaron that he is not to come whenever he chooses into the Most Holy Place behind the curtain in front of the atonement cover on the ark, or else he will die. For I will appear in the cloud over the atonement cover.

### Hebrews 10:22

#### Ezekiel 36:25 NIV

<sup>25</sup> I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you will be clean; I will cleanse you from all your impurities and from all your idols.

### Hebrews 10:26

#### Exodus 21:14 NIV

<sup>14</sup> But if anyone schemes and kills someone deliberately, that person is to be taken from my altar and put to death.

#### Numbers 15:30 NIV

<sup>30</sup> "But anyone who sins defiantly, whether native-born or foreigner, blasphemes the Lord and must be cut off from the people of Israel.

### Hebrews 10:27

#### Isaiah 26:11 NIV

<sup>11</sup> Lord, your hand is lifted high,  
but they do not see it.

Let them see your zeal for your people and be put to shame;

let the fire reserved for your enemies consume them.

### Hebrews 10:28

#### Deuteronomy 17:6-7 NIV

<sup>6</sup> On the testimony of two or three witnesses a person is to be put to death, but no one is to be put to death on the testimony of only one witness. <sup>7</sup> The hands of the witnesses must be the first in putting that person to death, and then the hands of all the people. You must purge the evil from among you.
